to a Stake x o. in the McDaniel line. thence N 31° W 38.20 chs. to a Rock
x o. thence N 64° E 34.70 chs. to a rock x o. thence N 65° E 27.68 chs. to
a Rock x o. on said River. thence down the meanders of said
River to the beginning corner containing two hundred and
twenty-eight and one fourth ($228\frac{1}{4}$) acres, being the same
more or less, and bounded by lands of the said Mr.
