96 I Deed The State of South Carolina  
George Green know all men by these presents that whereas  
George Green late of Greenville County and State aforesaid  
during his life intestate and undivided in the year 1868 died  
and possessed of two tracts of Land one containing 104 Acres and the  
other 96 Acres in all 100 Acres which has ever since remained in  
the possession of his widow (Delila Green) and whereas the said  
George Green (deceas) left remaining and surviving him as his heirs  
at law and distribute his widow (Delila Green) and eighth child  
known to us Daniel M. Green James Green Camelia Bridewell Mary  
Priestly W.H. Green W.M. Green and Pauline Piattus all of whom  
are above the age of twenty-one years and whereas no partition  
of the said real estate has ever been had  
and being desirous to have the same divided without recourse  
to the court and whereas the said real estate was surveyed at  
their request and by consent of all parties in interest on the  
2<sup>nd</sup> day of December 1884 by J.K. Dickson D.S. and by him  
divided into nine different tracts as follows Tract No 1 containing  
20 Acres Tract No 2 containing 20 Acres Tract No 3 containing 19  
Acres Tract No 4 containing 20 Acres Tract No 5 containing 20  
Acres Tract No 6 containing 19 Acres Tract No 7 containing 19 1/2  
Acres Tract No 8 containing 8 1/2 Acres and Tract No 9 containing 8 3/4  
Acres each tract having the mills and ponds corner and dis-  
tances as shown by the Plat of said survey number U.C. 123  
4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9 of which is hereunto attached and whereas by an  
act of all parties in interest Tract No 1 was assigned to Delila  
Green (widow) Tract No 2 was assigned to Daniel M. Green Tract  
No 3 was assigned to T.M. Green Tract No 4 was assigned to James  
Green Tract No 5 was assigned to Mary Priestly Tract No 6 was assi-  
gned to W.H. Green Tract No 7 was assigned to Pauline Piattus Tract No 8  
was assigned to T.M. Green Tract No 9 was assigned to Camelia Bridewell  
and each party into possession of the tract assigned to  
him and in consideration of the above done

George Green Camelia Bridewell Mary Priestly W.H. Green  
T.M. Green and Pauline Piattus for and in consideration that  
the said George Green has this day executed Bargained sold and delivered  
to me respectively all his right title and interest in and  
to the tract of Land assigned to us respectively as above set  
forth and in the further consideration of the sum of five  
dollars to me paid by the said W.M. Green the receipt whereof is  
hereby acknowledged have granted bargained sold and released  
and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto  
the said W.M. Green all my right title and interest in and to  
a certain lot or parcel of Land belonging to the estate of George Green  
(deceas) late in Greenville County and State aforesaid on Esome  
River and known as Lot No 8 in the J.K. Dickson made the 2<sup>nd</sup>  
day of December 1884 containing twenty-four acres more or less  
together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments  
to and appurtenances there unto belonging or in any wise incident  
or pertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises  
so before mentioned unto the said W.M. Green his heirs and res-  
ignee forever. But we do hereby bind ourselves our heirs executors  
and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular  
in the said premises unto the said W.M. Green his heirs and res-  
ignee against us and our heirs and against every other person  
or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any  
part thereof. Witness our hands and seals this eighteenth  
day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight  
hundred and eighty-four and in the one hundred and ninth  
year of the Independence of the United States of America
