 bargain, sell and release unto the said Silvia
 Garrett a certain lot or parcel of land, situate

 corporate limits of the City of Greenville on the North
 side of Broad Street, beginning at the corner of
 Aaron Maxwell's lot and running S. 23 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. to a Stake
 on Street, thence with said Street S. 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 46 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to a
 Stake, thence N. 19 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. to Aaron Maxwell's lot, thence
 with said lot 56 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to the beginning containing
 six thousand eight hundred and forty nine (6849) square
 feet, or 25 square Perches more or less. Together with
 all and singular the Rights, Members, Tenements
