 being more fully described by plat thereof made by J. W.  
 Southern Deputy Surveyor from a survey made by him  
 on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of October 1886. Together with all and singular  
 the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said  
 premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining,  
 To have and to hold all and singular the premises before  
 mentioned unto the said Margaret Bless her heirs and as-
