E. 30.20 to Hickory 3 x 3 m. thence S. 87 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 11.80 to a stone 3 x 3 m. on each side of Williams road, thence along said road 33.62 to beginning corner, adjoining lands of W.H. Evans, W.P. Wooden, G.E. Ware and others, (and being tract No 9 in the division of lands of Mrs. Mary Ware deed,) containing One hundred and fifteen acres, more or less. Being the same tract of land conveyed to me, the said G.M. Royals, by deed bearing date November 1st 1886, by S.J. Donahue, trustee for the County aforesaid.
