conveyed, sold and released and by these
presents do grant, convey, sell and release
unto the said J. S. Dorroh all that lot of land
situate in the City of Greenville, in the County
of Greenville and State of South Carolina, commencing
at the corner of J. J. Turners lot on Pendleton
Street, and running with said Street to the
corner of O'Bryans lot, thence with said O'Bryans
lot, thence with said O'Bryans lot to Augusta Street
thence with Augusta Street to the corner of J. J. Turners
lot, thence with said Turners lot (including
one half of the wall of the building on Turners
lot) to the beginning corner, being a portion
of the lot conveyed to me by W. G. Dean, and
having on it a Blacksmith shop. Together
with all and singular the Rights, Members,
Reverendments and appurtenances to the said
Premises belonging, or in anywise incident
or appertaining. To Have and to Hold, all and
