Garnett and others containing two hundred and
ninety five acres more or less and being the lands
deeded to said James A Cannon and James West
by separate deeds from Mark Cannon to J A Can-
non and by W. J. West to J. West both of which deeds
are recorded in R. M. C. in R. M. C. office of Summerville
County. To have and to hold the said premises unto
the said James A Cannon and James West their heirs
and assigns to their own proper use and behoof
forever so that neither the said Margaret James
or any other person in any name or behalf shall or
will hereafter claim or demand any right or title
to said premises or any part thereof but they and
every of them shall by these presents be excluded
