Know all Men by these Presents, that I, Thomas J. Harris in the State of aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Four thousand & fifty Dollars, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents, by Betty Williams (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Betty Williams, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situated lying and being in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, commencing at a stake 34, corner of Church lot and Bismie Street, running thence with said street N. 62 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W. 49 $\frac{1}{2}$  feet to stake, thence N. 27 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E. 217 $\frac{1}{2}$  feet to stake 34, thence S. 62 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E. 49 $\frac{1}{2}$  feet to corner of said Church lot, thence with line of said Church lot 217 $\frac{1}{2}$  feet to the beginning corner. Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold, all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said Betty Williams her heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself and my Heirs, Executors, and Administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Betty Williams her heirs and
