Mauldin all that lot or piece of land, situate, lying and being in the fourth Ward of the City of Greenville, County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, Beginning at a stake corner of Wesley Gowrie on the side Broad Street, thence S. 19 E. 131 feet to a stake x one, of said Wesley Gowrie, thence along the Laurens & Greenville Rail Road land N. 71 W. 100 feet to a stake x two, thence S. 19 W. 131 feet to a stake x three on said Broad Street, thence S. 77 E. 100 feet to the beginning corner, containing 13,100 square feet with the same more or less, and bounded by lands of said Wesley Gowrie, the said Laurens and Greenville Rail Road land, said Mrs. Howell and Broad Street, together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments, and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, not in anywise decided or appertaining, to have and to hold all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said Wm.
