and released and by these Presents do grant, bar-
gain, sell and release unto the said John Whitmire
a certain piece, parcel and tract of land situate
lying and being in the State & County aforesaid
and on waters of Beaufort Creek and having
the following lines metes and bounds to wit:

thence up the branch about 18.00 chains to a
