of the sum of Eleven Hundred and twenty-five  
Dollars, (\$1125) to me paid by I.C. Gower, E. J. S. Rowley,  
J. F. Dorroh, P. J. Hayne, H. J. Cook and Samuel Thompson,  
Trustees of the School District of the City of Greenville  
Have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these  
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the  
said I.C. Gower, E. J. S. Rowley, J. F. Dorroh, P. J. Hayne  
H. J. Cook and Samuel Thompson, Trustees aforesaid  
their successors in office and assigns all those two  
certain pieces, parcels and lots of land, situate, lying  
and being on Pendleton Street, in the City and County  
of Greenville in the State of one said, adjoining each other  
and designated as Lots Nos. 2 & 3 on the plat of the lands  
of the Homeestead place of the late T. E. Ware deceased,  
as made by J. N. Southwick D. S. Cash containing truly  
three-one hundredths (3 1/100) of an Acre, more or less, and  
each having a front and rear of one chain and fifty  
one links (151') in width, and a depth of four chains  
and twenty links (420') and the two together bounded  
as follows, to-wit: on the East by a street forty-four (44)  
feet wide, on the North by White Street and lot No. 4, on the

heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever  
defend all and singular to said premises unto  
the said I.C. Gower, E. J. S. Rowley, J. F. Dorroh, P. J. Hayne,  
H. J. Cook and Samuel Thompson, Trustees aforesaid  
their successors in office and assigns from and against  
myself, my heirs, and all other persons whomsoever  
lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part

my attorney in fact, this fifth day of March in the year  
of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty  
eight and in the one hundred and twelfth year of  
the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States  
of America.
