Jackson of State and County aforesaid (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,) have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said S. C. Jackson all that piece, parcel and tract of land situated, lying and being in Greenville County and State aforesaid, and known as a part of Lot No. 3 in a survey of Land made by James K. Dickson of the real estate of David McLain, deceased, Oct 3, 1882, and having the following lines, poles and bounds, to wit, viz: Beginning at a stone 3x on the Greenville Road and running thence S 9 W 9.38 to a stone 3x, thence S 42 W 280 to a stake in said Greenville Road, thence with the Road S 9 N 4.60 to a stake thence N 84 E 42.00 to a corner in the middle Fork of Piggs River, thence up the River with the meanderings of the same to a dead oak 3x, Jackson's corner, thence S 33-42 W 5.91 to a small pine 3x, thence S 80 E 33.28 to a stone 3x on said Greenville Road, thence N 10 E 50 links to a stone 3x, the beginning corner, containing (83 1/2) Eighty-three and one half acres by the same more or less.
