more or less, being a part of the land of said Luther B. Johnson and others, beginning on the back  
line, thence S. 19 E. to a black oak, then S. 87 W. 12 links to stake, then S. 24 E.  
20 ch. 34 links to stake on the East side of the Gap Creek near 3x S. 41x E. 6 ch. 2  
more or less, then S. 21 E. 17 ch. 25 links to chestnut oak 2x, thence  
S. 87 W. 37 ch. 36 links to saw wood 3x, thence S. 15 E. 11 ch. 15 links to a  
Hickory, thence S. 20 E. to the back line, thence S. with back line to Sarah  
J. Johnson line, thence with Sarah J. Johnson's line to the other
