stake on the North - 10 feet corner of Mulberry Street and running thence N 89° 48'  
100 feet along Mulberry Street thence N 44° W 100 feet thence S 07° 44' W 100 feet to a  
stake corner on said West street thence S 04° N 66° E 100 to the beginning corner said lot contains
