Dollars, to be paid in hand paid at and before the sealing
of these Presents, by *William Goldsmith*,
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,) have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, DO
GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said *J. C. Vaughan*, all that parcel

and tract of Land, situated and lying in Greenville County, State of South Carolina
being about 12 miles from the City of Greenville on the Greenville Road and having
the following Metres and bounds, Beginning at a stone 3 ft. in height
containing sixteen hundred and thirteen acres more or less and com-
prising there adjoining tract as follows, one tract of land containing six hundred
and fifty six acres more or less, being the tract conveyed to Mr. Goldsmith on the twenty-
third day of October, eighteen hundred and fifty six, and having such lines and
bounds as appear from a plat of the same recorded in Book 4 page 205 of the Office of the
Register of Deeds Conveyance of Greenville County, one tract containing forty eight acres more or less
adjoining the above in the south, and particularly described in a deed to the same from Samuel
Anchit Broome, page of Greenville County, bearing date November 21st, eighteen hundred and forty eight
and a tract of my account more or less composed of two small tracts purchased from John
Doyle by Mr. Goldsmith,
