Williams all that certain piece of land or lot bounded and situate lying and being in the city, County and State aforesaid and having the following waters and boundaries, viz.: Beginning at a stake on corner of Williams Street thence down John P. Williams line A 12 1/2 W 3-18 to stake corner of John P. Williams lot thence 0 04 1/2 W 2 9 0 to corner on McRae line thence 0 2 0 1/2 E 3 7 6 to corner on Calhoun Express lot thence along Calhoun Express line to corner on street thence across street N 1 1/2 E 2 0 4 ft to corner of lot No. 30 thence along street N 7 1/2 E 2 1 1/2 to corner of McKinney Walkers lot thence along McKinney Walkers line N 1 1/2 E 3 1 1/2 to Humphreys corner thence along Humphreys line N 7 1/2 E 9 0 ft to corner thence along Humphreys line N 1 1/2 E 3 1 1/2 to Williams Street then along Williams Street N 7 1/2 E 10 11 6 ft to the beginning corner. Garrison, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mary J. Garrison all that piece of land containing two hundred and nine acres more or less, situated lying in the County and State aforesaid about four miles south of Greenville east of town on the West side of the Calhoun and Greenville Rail Road and on both sides of the White Horse and Williamson roads and waters of Saluda River, and having the following waters and boundaries, viz.: Beginning at a stone from O.
