Georgia Road thence 0.64 1/8 acre to a stone 3 x 3 ft. at the corner & 16.56 to 200
ft. from thence 0.24 3/4 acre 37.23 feet eastward on said road thence with said
road 5.80 to a bend in said road thence with said road 11.25 to another bend thence with
said road 20.00 to another bend thence with said road 9.07 to another bend thence with said
road 11.00 to the beginning adjoining lands of W. C. Pollard Mrs. M. S. Bragg & others
