Jennings (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,) have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said L. J. Jennings a certain piece of land or part of land containing one hundred nine and a half (109 1/2) acres situate the same more or less situated and lying in the State of South Carolina aforesaid on Branches Branchwaters of Middle Saluda River beginning at Post Oak 3x30m from South 20 East 25.15 chains to a Rock & from thence South 166 1/2 East 15. to a red Oak 350 m down Rock 3x m. m Post Oak bounded on the North 1/2 West 40.00 chains to a Dogwood 3x30m thence North 37 1/2 West 25.00 to a Post Oak 3x30m down Rock 3x m. m thence North 62 1/2 E 28.75 chains to the beginning Post Oak & from bounded on the East side by lands of H.
