 adjoining A. B. Biggs lot and others beginning at a Stake 3x
 on corner of A. B. Biggs lot and running thence South 8 $\frac{1}{4}$ E 230 feet
 to a Stake corner of street thence North 26 $\frac{1}{4}$ E 272 feet to a Stake
 corner owned by J. T. Brun (now William Smith) thence N 8 $\frac{1}{2}$
 W 3 27 feet to a Stake on a S. Biggs Back line thence with
