of these Presents, by L. J. Goodwin & W. C. Corbin (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,) have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, DO  
GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said L. J. Goodwin & W. C. Corbin all of my rights &c in a certain piece or parcel of land held by me as trustee for the Walden Brook  
church in the State and County aforesaid being two acres conveyed to me by Walden Brook church  
of J. C. Allen on the 20th day of October 1889 for the purpose of using the privilege as a school ground  
for the colored children for the purpose of erecting in connection with or in assisting  
Walden Brook congregation in building a church upon said grounds said church  
when so built by the aforementioned assistance from the school Trustees to be used  
also for school purposes. The present arrangement to remain in force until the col-  
ored people and the school Trustees are able to build their school house and church  
separately and then in that event the Trustees to retain the rights and privi-  
leges of said land for the erection of a separate school house upon said two  
acres and retain the use or so much as necessary for school purposes
