 and County being a son of the said S. A. Davenport and entitled to a dis-
 tributed share of said land for and in consideration of the sum of one

 Davenport of same State and County have Granted bargained sold
 and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto
 the said Obadiah Davenport all my rights, title, share, part and estate
 it being the one sixth of the said Tract of Land above mentioned so
 together with all and singular the rights, numbers, residuaments and
 apportionments to the said premises belonging or in anywise in-
 cident or appertaining. To have and to hold unto the said Obadi-
 ah Davenport his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind my
 self my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever
 defend all and singular the above mentioned premises unto the said
 Obadiah Davenport his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs
