Many Carruth being the owner of the fee, in and entitled by any Mortgage, judgment or action whatsoever, of a certain tract of land, lying and being in the County of Grainville and state of South Carolina, containing One Acre more or less, Bounded as follows: Beginning on a Black Oak tree near S. E. corner of Tice House, thence due north seventy yards to a rock, thence due west seventy yards to Spanish Oak, thence due south seventy yards to a rock; thence due East seventy yards to the beginning corner.
