

parties as fully and completely as if it were drawn in that form and signed by the contracting parties and that the Mayor and Clerk of the City of Greenville South Carolina are hereby authorized and instructed upon the passage of this ordinance to execute duplicate copies with the seals of the City of Greenville and shall deliver one of these copies so signed and sealed on behalf of the City to said American Pipe Manufacturing Company and accept the other when signed and sealed by them on behalf of said City and cause it to be properly acknowledged and recorded according to law. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed and this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the date of its acceptance.

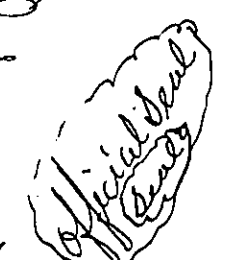
