I, Ashble R. Fowler, of the State of South Carolina, know all men by these presents that I Thomas B. Whitmore in the state aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Six Hundred Dollars to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents, by Ashble R. Fowler, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and release unto the said Ashble R. Fowler, all that piece of land situate lying and being in the City of Greenville in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid fronting on Townes Street in said City and containing 3 1/3 of an acre more or less and having the following lines and boundaries, Beginning at a stake on Townes Street and running S 40° E two hundred and three (203) feet to a stake on alley thence with said alley S 18 1/2 W fifty seven (47) feet to another stake on said alley thence N 03 1/2 W two hundred and nine (209) feet to a stake on Townes Street thence with said alley running S 40° E

to the begining corner the said lot being known as Lot No 4 on a plat made for Lewis W. Parker by J. M. Southern Surveyor of certain lands bought by said Parker from Julia D. Wier, and the Southern Baptist Theological Seminary the lot hereby conveyed being bounded on the North by lot No 3 of said survey now owned by H. C. Dargan on the South by lot No 2 on the East by said alley and on the West by Townes Street. Together with all and singular the rights Members Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

To have and to hold all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the said Ashble R. Fowler his Heirs and assigns forever, and in consideration of the said sum hereinbefore mentioned I have further granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and release unto the said Ashble R. Fowler his heirs and assigns the use of and right of way over two lanes or alleys lying and being contiguous to the lot hereby conveyed to him and to be used for the purpose of ingress and egress to and from the rear of said lot to wit, one lane or alley ten feet wide throughout its length extending from Townes Street to Main Street and the other with a width throughout of twenty feet and extending from the lane above mentioned commencing at a point two hundred and six (206) feet from either of above streets and running along the rear of the lot hereby conveyed two hundred and one (201) feet upon the condition however that the said Ashble R. Fowler his heirs and assigns shall pay one sixth of all expenses now or hereafter to be incurred in keeping in good repair the said alleys and the entrances thereto including gates thereto should such be desired the character of such repairs and the expense thereof to be determined by a majority vote of the owners of the six lots at the rear of which the second alley is situated being given one note for each lot he may own and said ground or right of way is to cease and determine whenever such lot owner shall neglect or refuse to pay his proportionate part of such expense or repairs.
