Whereas James P Boyce late of the State and City of meridit departed this life in 1887, seized and possessed in fee simple of the lands hereinafter described and leaving surviving him as his only heirs at law under the laws of the State of South Carolina his widow the said Elizabeth L Boyce and his daughter the said Elizabeth F Boyce, Francis W Boyce and Lucy G Boyce.
