have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents  
do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Ellison

R A Means as Trustees as aforesaid, all that certain piece  
parcel or lot of land lying and being in the City of Greenville  
in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid, containing  
fifty seven one hundredths of an acre more or less and

at the South West corner of Rhett and Wardlaw Streets  
running thence with Rhett St S 70 1/2 W Two hundred and
