the twenty fifth day of October 1890 and now on
file in said Court did expose the premises here
after described for sale at public outcry on Saturday
in December 1890 having first advertised the
same as required by law, and selling during
the legal hours of sale and said premises were
at such sale knocked down to Mrs Johanna Knebel
at the sum and price of Eight thousand one
hundred Dollars she being at that price the
last and highest bidder for the same.

that I the said Henry Knebel as Administrator
as aforesaid in consideration of the premises
and of said sum of Eight thousand one hundred
Dollars to me paid or secured to be paid by
the said Mrs Johanna Knebel and by virtue of
the Decretal Order of aforesaid have granted bargain
sold and released and do by these presents grant
bargain sell and release unto the said Mrs Johanna
Knebel all that piece parcel and lot of land situate
lying and being at the North East corner of Main
Street and the Public Square in the City of
Greenville and County and State aforesaid
beginning at a stake on Main Street and
running thence S 72 1/2 E one hundred and
fifty two and a half feet to a stake on a sixteen
foot alley thence with said alley S 17 1/2 W
twenty seven feet to a stake thence N 72 1/2 W one
hundred and fifty two and a half feet to

on said main street at the corner of the Public Square
and thence with said street N 14 1/2 E twenty seven feet to the
beginning corner. Together with all and singular the
rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the
said premises belonging or in anywise incident or app-
ertaining, and all the estate right title claim and interest
whatsoever of said Franz Hahn and of the parties to the
cause aforesaid and of each of them in and to the same
and of all other persons rightfully claiming from under
by or through them or either of them to have and to hold
all and singular the premises before mentioned unto
the said Johanna Knebel her heirs and assigns forever.
