Now know all men by these presents that the Piedmont Manufacturing Company in consideration of One Dollar to it paid at and before the sealing of these presents by B F McKenzie, F J Pool, W J Cliffford, J H Donney, J T Brown, J E Tice and J J Hammon Trustees of the Methodist Church South (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents does grant bargain sell and release unto the said B F McKenzie, F J Pool, W J Cliffford, J H Donney, J T Brown, J E Tice and J J Hammon

as Trustees of the Methodist Episcopal Church South and their successors in office, in trust that said premises shall be used kept maintained and disposed of as a place of divine worship for the use of the ministry and membership of the Methodist Episcopal Church South, and for church purposes only subject to the discipline usage and ministerial appointments of said Church at from time to time authorized and declared by the general conference of said Church and the annual conference within whose bounds the said premises are situated. All that certain piece parcel and lot of land situate lying and being in the County and State aforesaid on the South side of Main Street at the Bend in the town of Piedmont, Beginning at a Locust Tree on the edge of said Street, running thence S 21° E 2.70 to a stake S E corner.
