GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. O. Latimer all that piece parcel
or tract of land situate, lying and being in the County and State
aforesaid on waters of Belvoir dam and Mountain Creek containing
eighty three acres more or less and known as a portion of the
old Mr. David and Johnson place bounded by lands of Mr. M. David and Mr. Onachum and beginning lot of tract No 4 in
the division of the estate of Mrs. Abby Stokes deceased.

heirs and assigns forever
