mety and bounds, corners and distances, beginning at the said Adie R. Black's South East  
corner at a stake on the West side of the Springbank Road and running thence westerly one hundred and  
one hundred and nineteen and one half feet to the bridge across Richland Creek, thence one hundred and forty  
three feet to the water edge Richland Creek, thence north with the present meanderings,  
of said creek to its water edge two hundred and thirty-one feet to a stake to bend of said creek thence north one hundred and eight  
feet to the meanderings of said creek to its water edge two hundred and seventy-four feet to a willow, thence north one hundred and  
one hundred and nine feet to a stake, thence north one hundred and forty-eight feet to Mrs. Black's corner, thence with the Southern
