I George W. Owens of the City and County of Greenville in said State in consideration of the natural love and affection which I have for my father Samuel P. Wells in the State aforesaid, and also in consideration of the sum of

Five Dollars, to, save in hand paid at and before the sealing of these Presents, by Samuel P. Wells of said City and County of Greenville in the State aforesaid (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,) have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said Samuel P. Wells all of my right title

interest and estate of in or to all and singular the following described piece of land and lot of land situate and being within the corporate limits of the City of Greenville and State of South Carolina to wit: all that lot or parcel of land on the south west corner of Church street and Monroe Avenue Beginning at a stake on the corner of said street and running thence along

71 E one hundred and sixty and one half feet to a stake corner of the above lot thence along said lot *N 20 E* one hundred and twenty seven and one half feet to a stake *E 2 N 30 S* and so forth thence along said line one hundred and sixty two feet to a stake on Church Street thence along Church Street *S 18 W* one hundred and thirty two feet to the beginning containing forty six one hundredth of an acre more or less, being the same lot of land conveyed to as follows: Julius C. Smith and by Julius C. Smith to Fannie M. Wells and myself his wife to said Fannie M. Wells and one third to myself which said undivided one third is not intended to be and is not owned by these presents but for the right title placed in the other two thirds which I retain from my mother the said Fannie M. Wells now deceased.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the said Samuel P. Wells (with the exception of record) His Heirs and Assigns forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself and my Heirs, Executors and Administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said Premises unto the said Samuel P. Wells (subject to the exception aforesaid,) His Heirs and Assigns, against, save and except Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
