F. Tammars* and *Sallie Scott*, which plat is recorded R. M. G. Office for the County aforesaid, and consists lot No 5 and 6 on a plat of lots Nos 4 and 5 made by *C. H. D. Dickson* Aug 19th 91. Lot No 5 contains 4 acres more or less and has the following lines and marks. Beginning at a stake on north side of Wayne St corner of lot now belonging to *J. F.
