

north of the Public road and east of and below the ford of the
 creek. Thence from the mouth of said branch N.W. chains
 (only a short distance) to a small dam across on the right hand
 bank of a small branch which runs into Beaverdam from
 the opposite side and now empties into Beaverdam Creek
 just a little way above the branch aforementioned of
 the opposite side, this branch also empties into the creek
 below the ford. Thence up said branch to the ford, thence
 up right prong to next ford, thence up left prong to the
 head, thence from the head this small branch or dike
 a straight line N.W. to a chestnut 31 in ford of two small
 hollows, the hollow on our right being the one in which
 the next branch heads which runs down to our right
 Thence in the general direction of a high Pine on the west
 end or spur of Peter Mountain N.W. chains or to J. C. Cleveland
 line, thence with the lands of J. C. M. Bruce and W. C. Goodwin
 to beginning corner bounded by lands of J. C. Cleveland
 Bruce, perhaps Shumate W. C. & Goodwin, Together
 with all and singular the Rights Members Heredita-
 ments and Appurtenances to the said premises
 belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining
 To have and to hold all and singular the said prem-
 ises before mentioned unto the said Margaret
 Burrell and her heirs assigns forever) And I do
 hereby bind myself, my heirs Executors and
 Administrators to warrant and defend all and
 singular the said Premises unto the said Margaret
 Burrell her heirs and assigns against me and
 my heirs lawfully claiming or to claim the same
 or any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal

 nine, and in the 11th year of the Sovereignty and
