do hereby bind ourselves, as Executors aforesaid to
warrant and forever defend all and singular the said
premises unto the said W. C. Johnson, his heirs and
assigns, against us as Executors, and the heirs of George
Birmingham deceased, lawfully claiming the same or any
part thereof.
