Beginning at a stone 34 on the Greenville and Spartanburg line and running thence with said line N 73 E 6.94 to a Pine 34 thence N 10 chains to a Red oak 34 dead down on the South side of the Pinecomb Road thence up said Road 27.20 chains to a point to a Red oak dead and down thence S 51 N 12.17 to a stone on the West side of the road leading to Curlew Factory.

Thence with said Road 20.34 to a Stone 34 on the West side of said Road. Thence East 29.00 to the beginning containing seventy four and one fourth acres more or less, and represented by plat 505 B. and represented by the annexed plat. Together with all and singular, the Rights, members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging in in, any wise incidents or appertaining: To have, and to hold all and singular the said premises unto the said S.
