Thence S. 19 E 24.50 Ch. to a stone 34 N. Thence S 47 W 13.50 to stone in place of R.O. Thence S 13. E 18.50 to Caesar's Head Road. Thence East, with said road 45 Ch. to Sire McJustin's branch. Thence down and with said branch 41 Ch. to middle fork of Saluda River. Thence down and with said river 41 Ch. to small ash on north bank of said river. Thence N 45 E 1.10 Ch. crossing Jones Gap road to the beginning. Containing Five hundred and twenty seven acres, more or less. Also another small tract more and opposite Cleveland's mill in the forks of Jones Gap and mill creek roads, containing one half acre. Situate, lying and being in Cleveland Township, State and County aforesaid.
