Esquire, Commissioner of the Honorable Court of Equity for
Greenville District, at Greenville Court House in the said

part: Whereas, Nancy McKinney on or about the 6th
day of December, in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred and fifty four, exhibited her Bill of
Complaint in the Court of Equity, at Greenville Court
House in the said State, against Alexander McKinney,
William McKinney and others.

And the cause, being at issue before the Honorable Court,
came on to be heard at July Term, in the year of our
Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty five when the
