

The same may affect our aforesaid land.  
 Now, therefore, know all men by these presents, that we, the said  
 George A. Sudduth, J. C. Sudduth, Anna M. Barry, W. P. Sudduth and  
 Emma C. Trapier, in consideration of the premises and of the  
 sum of one dollar to us paid by the said "The Pelham Mills"  
 at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, (the  
 receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have given and granted  
 and by these presents do give and grant unto the said "The Pelham  
 Mills," its successors and assigns, the right and privilege of  
 increasing the height of the aforesaid dam four additional feet, so  
 that the height thereof shall be eighteen feet, two inches  
 and three-fourths of an inch, measured as aforesaid, of such  
 less height as to them shall seem meet and proper, and in  
 making such increase, to strengthen the foundation, or otherwise  
 add to the thickness of said dam, if the same shall be requisite,  
 and to rebuild or repair the same in the same manner, whenever  
 natural decay or damage from the elements, or otherwise, shall  
 render the same necessary. And we do hereby covenant and agree  
 to and with the said "The Pelham Mills," its successors and assigns,  
 for ourselves, our heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, and  
 all persons lawfully claiming by, through, or under us, or any, or  
 either of us, that we will not, nor will any or either of us, make  
 any claim whatever against the said "The Pelham Mills," its successors  
 or assigns, for any injury to the aforesaid land, or to the crop or  
 crops planted or growing thereon from time to time, or otherwise,  
 caused by the said dam as now existing, or as the same may be  
 hereafter changed within the limits aforesaid; and the said  
 "The Pelham Mills," its successors and assigns, shall and may  
 at all times hereafter, peaceably and quietly have, use and enjoy  
 said dam as now existing, or as the same be hereafter raised, or  
 rebuilt, within the limits ~~of~~ aforesaid, free from any let, hindrance,  
 molestation or annoyance by or from us, or any or either of us  
 forever. Our witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands  
 and seals this 4th day of Sept, in the year of our Lord one thousand, eight  
 hundred and ninety-three, and in the hundred and seventeenth year of the  
 United States of America.
