And I hereby consent that the said Child may be named or called by any name the said Garrison may be pleased or choose to call him.

I, the said P.C. Garrison, on my part do hereby accept the gift of the said Child, and Covenant and Promise that I will use the utmost of my endeavor to teach the said Child in every way for his utmost good and benefit, and that I will procure and provide for him, sufficient meat, bread, Clothing and Lodging agreeable to my circumstances and station in life during that period. And for the true and faithful performance of all and singular the Covenants and agreements aforesaid, the said parties bind themselves each to the other firmly by these presents.
