County of Greenville. I Deed to Child.

A Contract, entered into this day between Mary Jane Green of the first part & Harriet Ross of the second. Mary Jane Green gives to Harriet Ross her boy child, named Franklin Wakefield, now in his 3rd year, since the 23rd Sept., 1893, for her to rear, relinquishing all her claims & interest in said child until he is 21 years of age; Provided, said Harriet Ross feeds, comfortably & respectably clothes & sends said child to the free public schools while they are open, or at least as much as she can, to teach him to be truthful & honest, & to teach him religion & good morals. - Said Harriet Ross agrees on her part to take said Franklin Wakefield, son of Mary Jane Green, as a gift until he is 21 yrs. of age; to feed him, comfortably & respectably, clothe him, send him to the free schools as much as she can, teach him to be truthful & honest & teach him religion & good morals, to care for & nurse him in sickness, & be of all necessary expenses in rearing said child.
