 John Lee, and desires to continue to live with him:


Now, know all men by these presents, that I, Maggie J. Johnson,

 for and in consideration of the premises above stated, and
 also in consideration of the sum of five dollars to me in
 hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents (the
 receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), by the said John Lee, have
 bound, transferred, bargained and sold, and by these presents do
 bind, transfer, bargain & sell unto the said John Lee and his heirs
 my said son, John Johnson, for and during the term of his
 minority and until he shall reach the age of twenty-one years,
