I, D. P. Werner, Master in and for the County of said said

Whereas the Paris Mountain Water Company a corporation duly created, organized and operating under the laws of this State, on or about the twenty third day of April eighteen hundred and ninety four, exhibited its complaint in the Court of Common Pleas for Greenville County in the State aforesaid, against Matilda Ann Holdman, Emma Skive, Charlotte Skive and others, demanding judgment in relation to the land hereinafter mentioned, and described and certain easements, rights and privileges upon and over other lands adjoining the same, and the cause being at issue came on to be heard on the 22nd day of November 1894, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that upon payment to said Master by the said Paris Mountain Water Company of the sum of One hundred Dollars, the said Master should execute to the said Paris Mountain Water Company a good and sufficient title to the land hereinafter described and conveyed, and also a sufficient grant of certain easements set out in the complaint of said Plaintiff and in the agreement herein referred to as by reference to said decree now file in said Court will appear, and the said Paris Mountain Water Company having paid the said sum of money and in all respects complied with the conditions in said decree mentioned. Now therefore know all men by these presents, that I, the said D. P. Werner, Master in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, in consideration of the performance of the conditions aforesaid and the payment of the said sum of One hundred Dollars by said Paris Mountain Water Company, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Paris Mountain Water Company, its successors and assigns, All that piece parcel and lot of land situate lying and being in Paris Mountain Township Greenville County and State aforesaid adjoining lands of estate of George Holdman, deceased and others and having the following lines, metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at a stake & iron branch and running thence N 22 1/2 E 3.00 ch to a stone
