Whereas a petition was filed in the Probate Court for said State and County on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of January 1878 by Michael B. Harrison and others against Wade H. Harrison and others to forfeit the real estate of Nancy Harrison deceased and return the said real estate lawfully forfeited under said proceedings, and whereas it has since been decided by the Supreme Court that the Probate Court was without jurisdiction in such cases, and whereas it became necessary to institute proceedings in Court of Common Pleas for the State and County aforesaid to confirm the said petition and return a complaint was filed in said Court of Common Pleas on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of October 1879 by Michael B. Harrison against James H. Harrison and others and upon the hearing of said cause the said Court amongst other things did order Adjudge and decree, That the said forfeiture be confirmed, and that the master should execute to the present owners of the respective tracts of land confirmatory titles, and whereas Michael B. Harrison had had no third interest in the tract of land assigned to him, James H. Harrison and Julia H. Harrison jointly in said forfeiture in the Probate Court to W. Benson Harrison and Julia Harrison whereas the said James H. Harrison and Julia Harrison subsequently sold their interests in said tract of land to J. H.
