Whereas James H. Maxwell, F. W. Poe & J. G. Hays did on the 2nd day of August 1891 file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration signed by themselves setting forth

The name and residence of the said petitioners to be as above named Fall of Currituck Co. Second The name of the proposed incorporating to be that of "The Currituck Clothing and Shoe Company." The principal place of business Currituck Co. The general purpose and nature of the business is the buying and selling of merchandise of all kinds, wholesale and retail, also the buying, selling and leasing of real real estate as may be necessary for their use for the purpose above stated.

Third The amount of Capital stock to be Fifty thousand Dollars, and the number of shares into which the same is to be divided to be One hundred and fifty of the par value One hundred Dollars each.

And whereas on the 2nd day of August 1891 the said above named petitioners were commissioned by me a Board of Corporators authorizing and empowering them to have of subscribers to the Capital stock of said proposed Corporation giving not less than one day previous notice by advertisement in a newspaper published in the County of Currituck, giving notice of the time and place when said books of subscription would be open And whereas The said Board of Corporators on the 7th day of August did file with the Secretary of State a return in writing, with their signatures certifying among other things, that more than 50 per cent of the Capital stock has been subscribed; and that the
