Whereas by virtue of a writ of Habeas Facias issued out of the Court of Common Pleas held for the County of Granville, dated the twenty ninth day of May in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety five at the suit of H. B. Buckhalter, J. F. Grandy and J. R. Buckhalter parties under the name of Buckhalter Grandy Company to me directed commanding the Way of the Road and Chattle lands tenements of H. B. Buckhalter & Company to pay the sum of one hundred and thirty six ⁹³/₁₀₀ dollars damages and costs and have seized and taken of the lands and tenements of the said H. B. Buckhalter and Company all that certain piece parcel and tract of land containing two rods and twenty poles across more or less situated and being in the County of Granville in the State aforesaid within the corporate limits of the City of Granville in the State aforesaid on the West side of the Anderson Road commencing at a Right Corner on said Road thence N 64. W 27.5 Ch to a State X 111. thence S. 48. W 1.50 Ch. along the West thence N. 52. 1/2. E. 3.37 Ch to a State X 111. thence N 26. E. 2.41 Ch to the beginning corner and containing two rods and twenty poles more or less the same being bounded by Lot No 18. a Street, Lot No 20, and the Anderson Road, and here fully represented in a survey shown by me to said Surveyor, Lot No 19, and being same lot of land conveyed by J. F. Payne to H. B. Buck-
