

The State of South Carolina

Know all men by these Presents, That the City Council of Greenville, in the State of aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred Dollars to it in hand paid, at and before the sealing of these presents by O. P. Mills, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents Do Grant, bargain sell and release unto the said O. P. Mills Lot No. 8 of Springwood Cemetery, having the following dimensions, to wit: Twenty feet wide, by twenty feet long for the right of burial and cemetery purposes, and to be used exclusively for the right and purpose aforesaid, and subject to the conditions of the Charter of said grantor and all revisions and amendments that may be made thereto, and also subject to the Ordinances of said City and the rules, regulations and by-laws of the City Council and Cemetery Trustees or Committee, now in force or which may hereafter be passed, relating to said cemetery and the burial of the dead therein,

Together with all and singular the said Rights Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining

To Have and to Hold, all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the said O. P. Mills his heirs and assigns forever, subject, however, to the limitations and conditions hereinbefore imposed.

And it does hereby bind itself and its successors in office to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said Premises unto the said O. P. Mills his heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors in office, and against every other person, whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

Witness the seal of said City Council of Greenville this 18th day of September A. D. 1894, in the year of our Lord one thousand, eight hundred and ninety four, and in the one hundred and 19th year of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America.
