 the same to which his or their father
 or parents would have been entitled if
 living, but should he die in the life time

 no child or children surviving, or of such
 child or children, or the issue of a deceased
 child or children shall survive for all all
 the before attaining the age of twenty one
 year then in trust for the use of the
 said Henry C. B. McCormick his heirs
 and assigns forever, and should the said
