Davis, Aquilla Long* and others containing one hundred and ten acres more or less, being the same land purchased by *W. J. Davis* from the heirs at law of *W. J. Davis* and purchased by *Thomas Maryly Cox* at the sale by the ordinary of the land of the estate of the said *W. J. Davis*.
