Stroud line South 24 1/2 E to the Greenville and Asheville Road, thence with said road in the direction of Greenville D. C. to a stone st in said road, thence S 64 E 800 to the Beginning corner containing 15 fifteen acres more or less and known as lot No 1 in a survey made by John M. Dalley for J. C. Dickson being part of the John Garman Land
