of One Dollars to in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Rosaline Hudson together with the foregoing premises (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Rosaline Hudson, all of that tract or plantation of land

situate in the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville seven miles East of the City of Greenville on a branch of Rocky Creek Waters of Emorse River, Partaining one hundred and eleven (111) acres, more or less, and having such marks bounds as follows: Beginning on a stone 540, thence N 40° W H 6,90 to a pine 510, thence S 30° W 73,00 to a stone 510, thence S 57° E 37,80 to a Hickory 510, thence N 51° E 29,68 to the beginning bounded by lands formerly owned by R. G. Hultzelaw, H. B. Deaver and others and known as the Red Caled Green places,

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in any-wise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said Rosaline Hudson her Heirs and Assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind myself my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Rosaline Hudson her Heirs and Assigns, against me and my Heirs, and every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
